Previous Bond Annulment Facts & Example:

**First** marriage must be presumed valid – no declaration of nullity of this marriage.

Example: Joseph [non-Catholic] marries Betty [non-Catholic] at First Presbyterian Church, Junction, MN.

Joseph & Betty divorce

Joseph marries Esmeralda at the Courthouse in Oops, MN

Joseph and Esmeralda divorce

Joseph marries Sue at the Courthouse in Podunk, MN – Betty is still living

Joseph and Sue divorce

Now Sue wants to marry Peter at Our Lady of Eternal Hope in Swoosh, MN

Sue is the petitioner in this case and Joseph is the respondent. The marriage of Joseph and Esmeralda is of no consequence in this petition.

If one of the principals [petitioner or respondent] is/was Catholic at the time of this marriage, then a Lack of Canonical Form decree of nullity will be issued.
