## SELECTION OF SCRIPTURE READINGS

- a. For the celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation, there are several options for readings found in the Lectionary (#764-#768). These readings may be used on any day <u>except</u> Saturday Evening (if it fulfills the Sunday obligation) and the Sundays of Advent, Lent, Ash Wednesday, Holy Week, the Easter Season, and Solemnities when the readings of the day <u>must</u> be used.
- b. During the Easter Season, the *first reading* is <u>always</u> taken from the Acts of the Apostles. The *second reading* is taken from one of the Letters of the New Testament. During the Easter Season, it is <u>not</u> appropriate to have an Old Testament reading.
- c. Outside the Easter Season, it is most appropriate to have an Old Testament *first reading*, a New Testament Letter for the *second reading*, and a Gospel reading.
- d. <u>Transfer the citations of the selected scripture readings to the appropriate section on Page 1.</u>
