



# Eucharistic Revival Pilgrimage

**SAVE THE DATES** **May 22-24**

**Northern route of Eucharistic Revival Pilgrimage passes through the St. Cloud Diocese.**

Four separate Eucharistic Revival Pilgrimages – starting from California, Texas and Connecticut and Minnesota – lead to the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis. The northern arm, called the Marian route, will pass through the Diocese of St. Cloud May 22-24.

The procession arrives in Mora on the afternoon of May 22. That evening, the eucharistic procession will arrive at Sts. Peter and Paul Church in Gilman. On May 23, it moves to both Our Lady of Lourdes and St. Mary churches in Little Falls, followed by a visit in Long Prairie. It then travels to Our Lady of the Angels and St. Paul churches in Sauk Centre and ends the day at St. Mary's Cathedral in St. Cloud. On May 24, the pilgrimage continues to St. Marcus Church in Clear Lake for a closing ceremony, the last site on the Marian route in the St. Cloud Diocese.

All are invited to become pilgrims with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, whether for one block or 10 miles. Along the way, parishes have planned Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, the Sacrament of Reconciliation, communal prayer, praying Divine Mercy, praying the rosary, praise and worship and fellowship.
