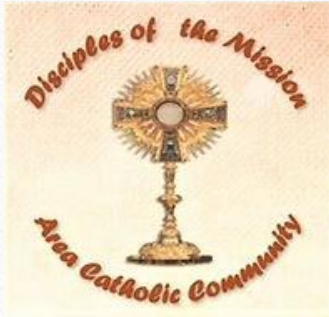

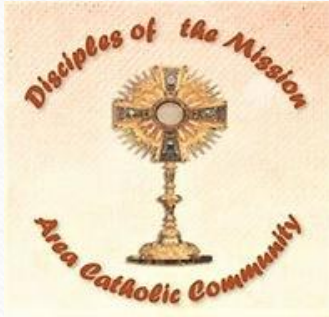
Building Relationships

- Breaking down silos by continuing to promote and create community events to include all seven parishes



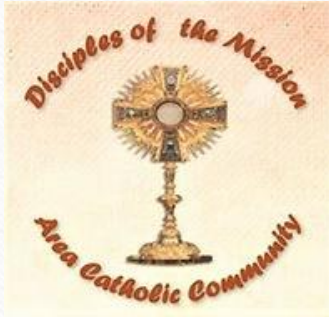
Building Relationships

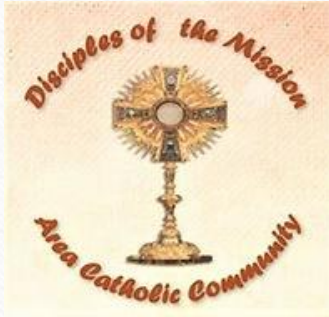
Listening

- ACC Pastoral Council



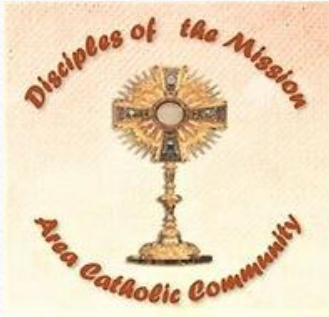
ACC Struggles

- Geography (distance for people to travel and a central location for events)
- Cohesive communication between the pastors
 - Addressing concerns of parishioners who are resisting the seven parish ACC
- Sharing resources (pulling on strengths of resources in all seven parishes)
- Clearer communication on who does what
 - Single point of contact
 - Bulletin and website submissions
 - Event announcements



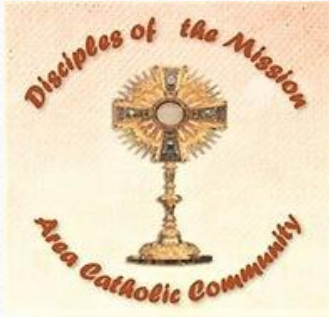
ACC Struggles

- Very much three and four separate parish clusters
 - Little incentive for the seven to come together
- Faith formation
 - One each in the three northern parishes
 - ACC Youth Director in the four southern parishes
- Changes in pastoral leadership in the past two years
- Covid pause – created divisions



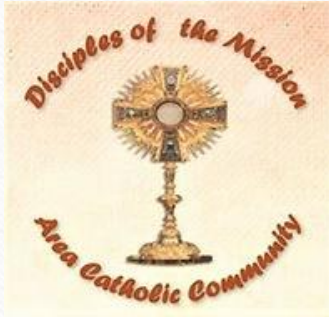
Nurturing Eucharistic Spirituality

- Volunteer appreciation



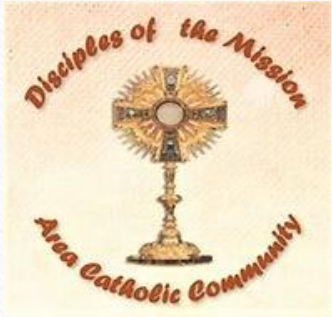
Formation of Leaders

- Called & Gifted Program
