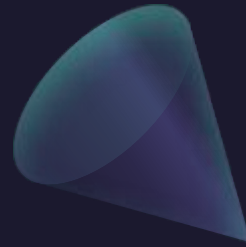

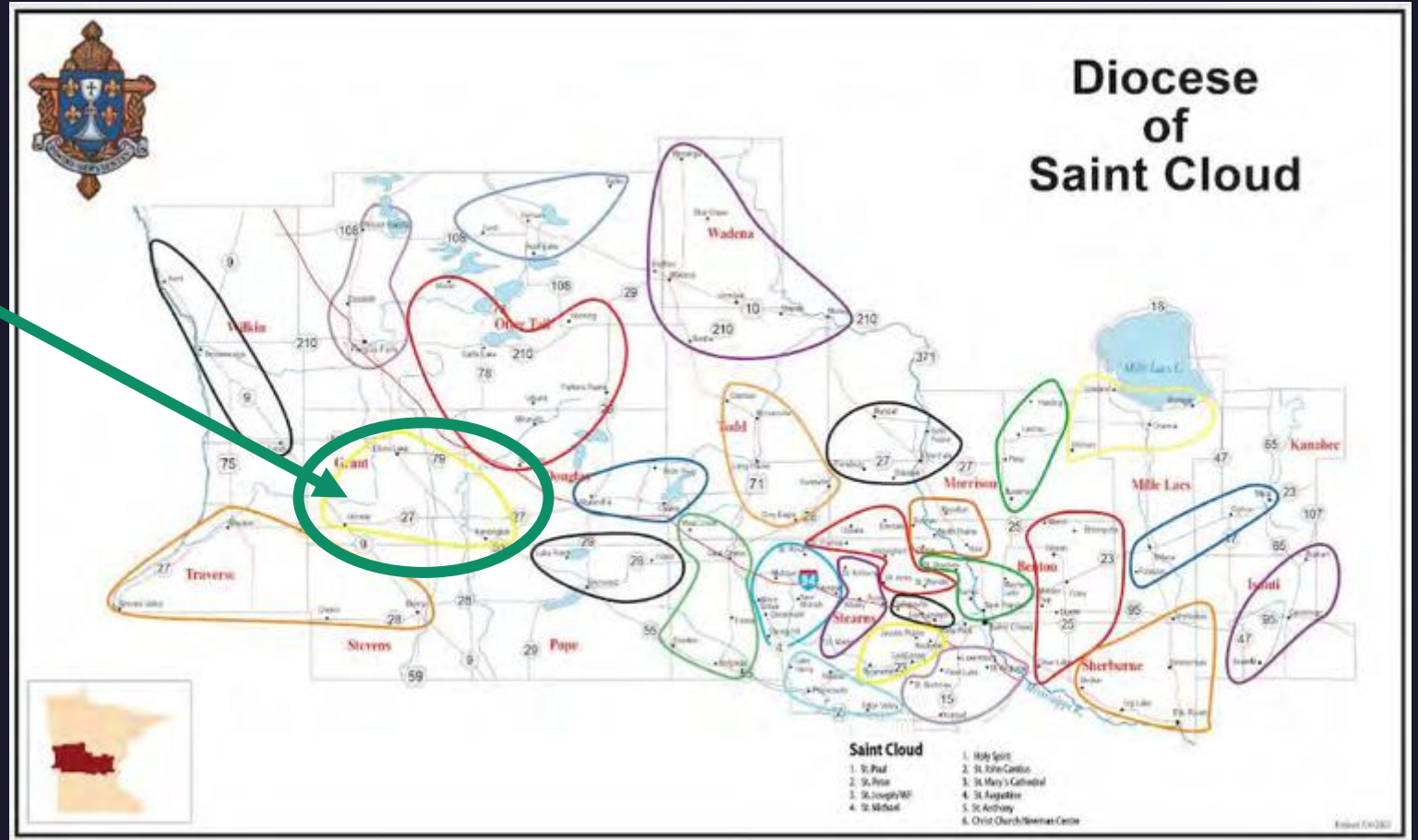
Who we are - West Central MN Roots

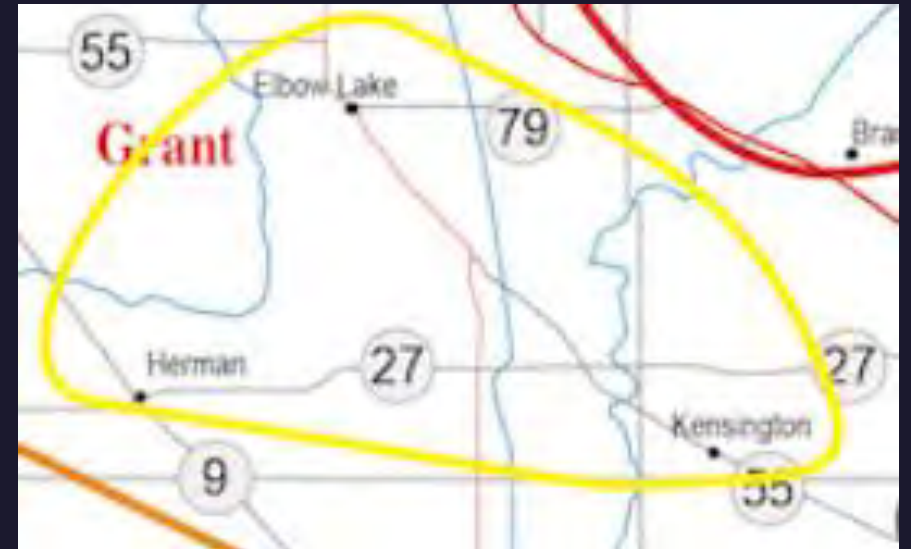
