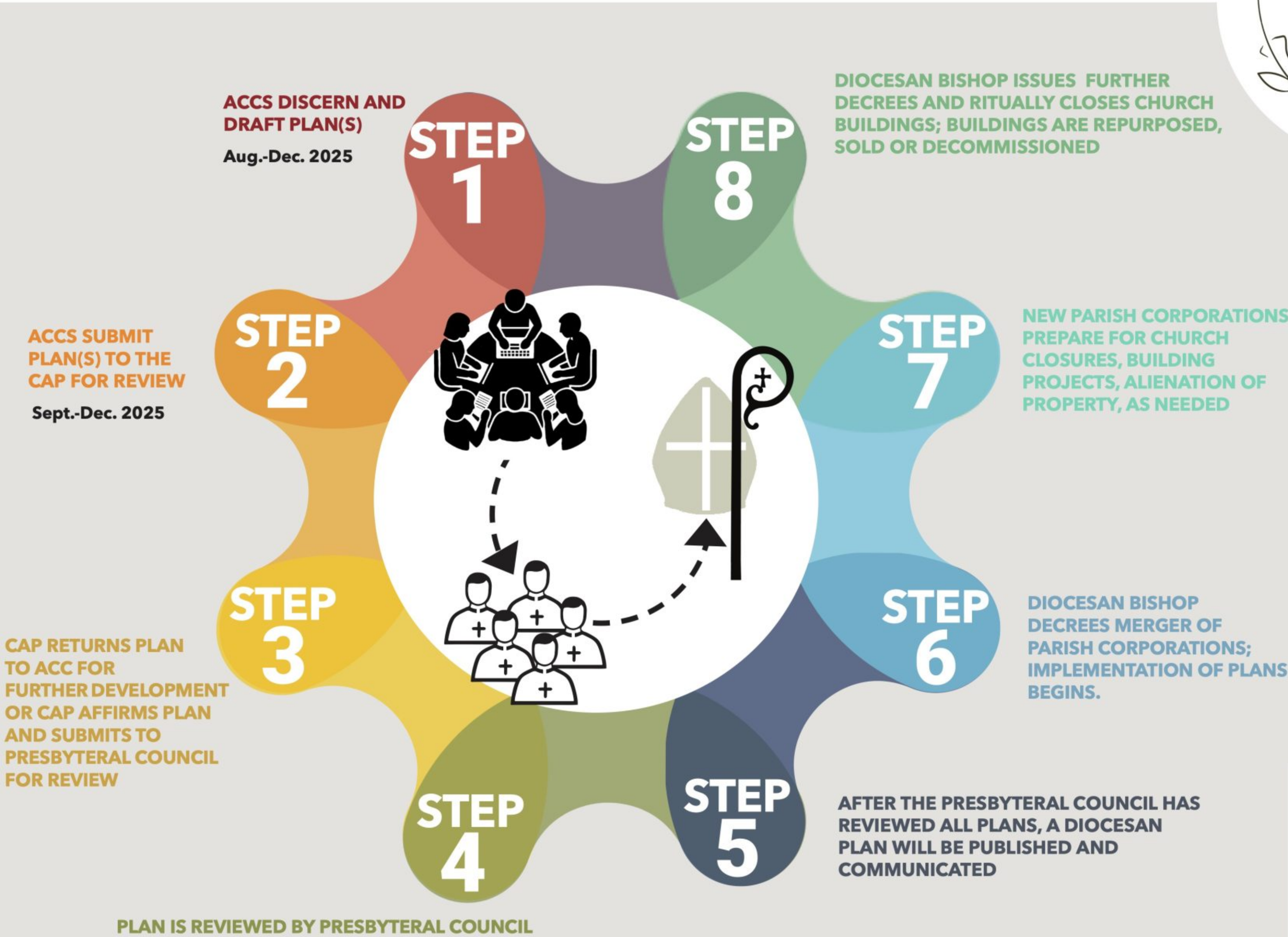


All Things New Process Timeline



This infographic outlines key milestones in our restructuring journey. It highlights when major steps will occur and how they build toward our shared mission. A Committee for the Affirmation of Plans, or the CAP, reviews proposals submitted by ACCs, referencing their conformity to the parameters the diocese set forth. The CAP consists of six members, including the diocesan director of planning, a canonical representative, a pastor, a parish administrator, the diocesan director of finance and an ad hoc representative. Members of the CAP deliberate with the ACC representatives. CAP members vote in favor of or against the plan. A favorable vote is transmitted to the diocesan bishop, along with a copy of the plan. In the case of an unfavorable vote, the CAP will work with the ACC to fine tune the plan and re-submit for affirmation. While dates provide structure, flexibility remains essential as we move forward together in faith. Each individual ACC will move at their own pace in preparing for any changes.
